Any studio art student from Summer 2008 through Spring 2009. Limit: 2 Pieces. Works must be part of a class assignment. If your work was taken from another source, credit the source on a separate piece of paper and attach to the back of your work.

Nine \$50 cash Merit Awards and CLC Purchase Awards. (Purchase Awards will be placed in the CLC Permanent Art Collection. See the checkbox on the entry form.)

NOTE: All 2-D must have PICTURE WIRE or it will be rejected. See guidelines on back.

- Work may be in any media and **must be dry!**
- Drawings & mixed media must be **framed** under **glass** or **plexi**

- Any medium; large pieces should be submitted via digital images on a CD, jpeg format
- All works must be original
- Must be in DVD or CD format. A monitor will be provided by the Gallery.

ENTRIES

No entry fee. Limit: 2 works per artist. Entry Forms: Download forms on the Gallery website: <http://gallery.clcillinois.edu> Entry forms will also be available in art studios and in the Gallery.

SALES

All works may be listed for sale at a *reasonable* price for student work. Most students have not established a "fair market value" for their work and should consult with their instructor for advice. Works selected for the show will be insured for up to \$150, but the sale price may exceed that amount.

A commission of 35% will be retained by the Gallery on work sold, including Purchase Awards. Price your work accordingly.

LIABILITY

Only accepted works will be insured for up to \$150 for the duration of the show. A value must be indicated for your work, even though you may list it as NFS (Not For Sale).
